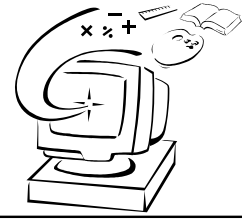


# SCHOOL VENDING MACHINES? LESSON PLAN



## WEEK 3 - DAY 12 & 13

### Lesson Objectives:

- Identify the impact of technology applications on society
- Demonstrate knowledge of the relevance of technology
- Apply appropriate search strategies to obtain information
- Integrate two or more productivity tools
- Demonstrate appropriate use of fonts, styles, and sizes
- Conduct research using online, print, or library resources
- Study and document an issue from more than one perspective
- Use a word processing application to create a graphic organizer

### Instructional Strategies:

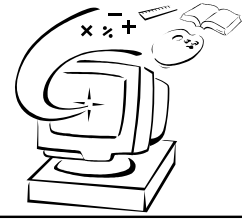

### Instructional Flow:

In this activity, students conduct research on the issue of whether or not vending machines should be in schools. Students use a variety of resources to find information about both sides. Students then use a word processing application to create a graphic organizer presenting their information.

- Use a Web template in a word processing application to create a Web site

### Instructional Flow:

Many organizations now publish large amounts of information on Web sites. In this activity, students examine the advantages of Web publishing as opposed to traditional publishing. Students are asked to create a Web site to post information about their own school. Students use a Web template in a word processing application to create the Web site.
